Metacognition is about the ways learners monitor and purposefully direct their learning.

Motivation is about our willingness to engage our metacognitive and cognitive skills and apply them to learning.

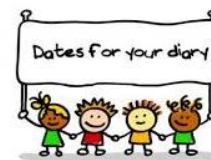
