"Eliminating unnecessary workload around marking" – Report published March 2016

Ofsted recognises that marking and feedback to pupils, both written and oral, are important aspects of assessment. However, Ofsted does not expect to see any specific frequency type or volume of marking and feedback.

'In the moment marking' is now much more common in our school, with teachers providing instant feedback and improvement strategies, rather than the more traditional written feedback at the end of a piece of work.

Teachers will always acknowledge the children's work either through written marking or a conversation with the child.

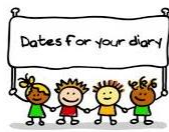
