Michael Morpurgo Visit Y4/5

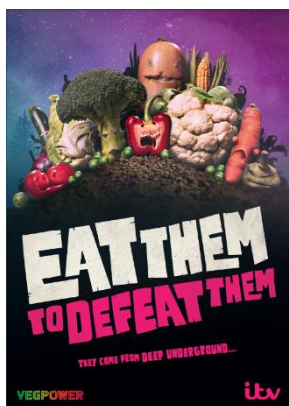

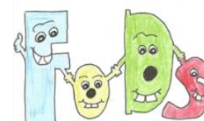
Eat them to Defeat Them
