- 8) Read *Horrible Science: Ugly Bugs* and draw a labelled diagram with an insect.
- 9) Read *The Abominables* by Eva Ibbotson and write a persuasive letter to a member of staff to convince them that yetis either exist or don't exist (you can choose your viewpoint)
- 10) Read *Revolting Rhymes Goldilocks* by Roald Dahl and write a persuasive paragraph about why Goldilocks was in the wrong.
- 11) Read *Horrible Histories: Vicious Vikings* and draw a labelled diagram of a Viking warrior.
- 12) Read *Beast Quest* and write about a quest of your own.
